**EXTRACTION FROM THE MEDIA STATEMENT BY THE MINISTER OF BASIC EDUCATION
27/06/2021:**

- Public schools will come back from the winter vacation early, on **19 July 2021**, instead of 26 July 2021; as it was originally scheduled in the 2021 School Calendar.

If any other amendments are made by the President, Cyril Ramaphosa, on 11 July 2021, at his Family Meeting, regarding the returning of learners to the school, parents will be notified immediately.

We request parents to be vigilant and remain safe, Do not gather in crowds, apply hygiene practices at all times, and avoid activities that may expose learner to infections.
