



PEDESTRIAN SAFETY



Walk on the sidewalks whenever they are available.

If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic, as far away from cars as possible.



Keep alert at ALL times when crossing the road, do not be distracted by electronic devices or friends.



Whenever possible, cross the road at a Robot or a Zebra crossing. ALWAYS stop and look both ways before you cross the road



If a crosswalk or robot is not available, locate a well lit area where you have a good view of the cars. Never cross the road at a bend - due to driver blind spots.

Be visible at all times. Wear bright coloured clothing during the day and reflective material/use a torch at night. **Regularly go over rules for safe bicycle riding.

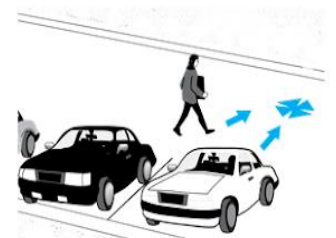


DRIVER AWARENESS



ALWAYS slow down at a school zone. Look out for pedestrians at all times, safety is a shared responsibility.

When reversing at the pick up point, be aware of your surrounds. Watch out for pedestrians.



ALWAYS yield to pedestrians at Zebra crossings. And ensure that you stop far back enough to allow safe crossing.

BE ALERT for cyclists when opening your vehicle door. Remind children to inspect surroundings before opening their door.



CAR SEATS:

Car seats should always be installed in the back seat of the car, never in the front.

Children should stay in the rear-facing position for as long as possible — until they reach the maximum height or weight as listed by the car seat manufacturer.
