** BIRTH CERTIFICATES **

All schools now require an <u>Unabridged Birth Certificate</u> as part of their learner registration applications. Under the National Education Policy Act 1996, all South African schools are required to legally verify a learner's biological parents. Although many parents make a declaration to schools regarding a child's parentage, their statements are sometimes found to be false, placing the school in a legal quagmire, therefore most schools are requesting Unabridged Birth Certificates. We request that these documents be submitted as part of the registration process.
